Following the discussion all the councillors voted for the existing contractor Complete Weed Control to continue. The quote for the playground was accepted from Complete Weed. The tractor value is estimated by Scunthorpe Lawnmowers to be £1500. The annual mower Insurance is due. Following a discussion all the parish councillors voted to let Scunthorpe Lawnmowers sell the mower. No insurance will be payable.
