MINUTES OF THE EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF THE COUNCIL HELD ON MONDAY 25 MARCH 2024 AT 6:15PM

72/2324 APLOGIES

The Clerk had received apologies from Cllr T.Moody.

73/2324 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

There were no Declarations of Interest.

74/2324 PROPOSAL FROM CLLR A.WOODHOUSE

Cllr Woodhouse had previously advised fellow Councillors by email that he had a proposal for an alternative to the purchase and installation of Speed Indicator Signs (SIDS) in the village as approved by Council on 11 March 2024 (68/2324 v.)

Cllr A.Woodhouse presented details of the Auto Speed Watch system which uses cameras to record speeding vehicles. The equipment is being trialled by Humberside Police in Bubwith.

Cllr E.Yorke enquired whether the cameras are installed in addition to SIDS.

Cllr A.Woodhouse said that this was not normally the case and explained that Auto Speed Watch is intended to monitor areas that the CSW group were unable to cover. He advised that the number volunteers in the village group was decreasing. Cllr M.Everratt suggested that the Council FaceBook page could be used to try and recruit new members. The Clerk is to action this.

Cllr E.Yorke proposed that the plan to install SIDS should go ahead with the proviso that if the village CSW group reported after a set period of time, that they were having no effect, then the option of adding Auto Speed Watch cameras could be considered.

The proposal was seconded by Cllr M.Everratt and a vote took place.

The result was 5 in favour, one against and was carried.

75/2324 REPLACENT CHRISTMAS TREE

Cllr M.Everratt advised that she had sourced a tree at an approximate cost of £40, Councillors gave full approval for it to be purchased.

There being no further business, the meeting closed at 6:40pm.
